17. Repeat steps 16-18 three more times.
18. Join the round with a sl st in the top of the first dc.

## Round 4: Shaping the Square

20. Chain 3 (ch 3).
21. Double crochet (dc) into the ch 2 space of the previous round.
22. Chain 2 (ch 2).
23. Repeat steps 21-23 two more times.
24. Chain 3 (ch 3).
25. Double crochet (dc) 2 times into the corner space.
26. Chain 3 (ch 3).
27. Repeat steps 27-29 three more times.
28. Join the round with a sl st in the top of the first dc.

## Finishing the Square

30. Fasten off the yarn and weave in any loose ends.
31. Congratulations! You've successfully created your first 3D granny square.

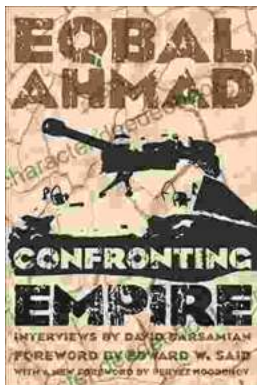

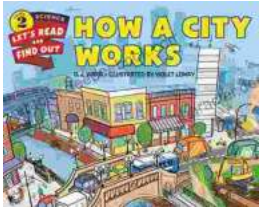
