



2. Beach Read by Emily Henry




3. Red, White & Royal Blue by Casey McQuiston

4. The Hating Game by Sally Thorne




5. The Unhoneymooners by Christina Lauren

6. The Spanish Love Deception by Elena Armas



7. A Very Merry Bromance by Lyssa Kay Adams






